

Home School agreement Covid-19

By attending Hillary Primary school, we agree to the following: in order to keep everyone safe.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide an environment that has been risk assessed in response to the Covid-19 pandemic. • Adhere to the social distancing and hygiene rules set out by the government. • Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs. • Contact carers/parents if your child displays symptoms of Covid-19. • Inform parents/carers if someone within your child's 'bubble' shows symptoms of Covid-19 and/or tests positive. The school will then provide home learning for 14 days (or until the test comes back negative). • Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions following the behaviour policy, as well as the expectations for all as outlined in this agreement. • Communicate between home and school through the website, social media and class charts. • Send work home for those children that are unable to keep to the agreement. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adhere to social distancing rules in class, the playground, corridors and walking to/from school. • Stay in my bubble all day. • Tell an adult if I feel unwell. • Keep all my belongs at home (don't bring things into school or take things home). • Use only the equipment provided to me by school. • Only enter and exit the school building from the designated gates/doors. • Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into an elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it- kill it). • Follow good hand hygiene- use soap and warm water for 20 seconds and alcohol based hand sanitiser. • Follow the 5R's (my teacher will remind me of these) to maintain the safety of myself and others at all times. • Know that if I can't follow this agreement, I can only return to school once my parent/carer and school both agree I am safe. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of Covid-19, I will not send them to school and we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family. I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone. • If my child, or another child in the bubble, shows symptoms of Covid-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately. • I will walk to school with my child (where I live close enough to do so), holding their hand, so that we can keep a 2-meter distance. • On my commute to school, I will adhere to the 2-metre social distancing rule. • The same adult will drop off and collect children in order to reduce the risk of infection. • When dropping off and collecting, I will stick strictly to the times given by the class teacher. • My child must not bring any items to school, other than a packed lunch and water bottle. • My child will have their temperature taken on arrival, dismissal and during the day if they feel or present as being unwell. • I will remind my child to follow the social distancing rules. • I accept that it is not always possible for children and adults to follow the social distancing rules successfully. • I will teach my child to follow good respiratory and hand hygiene. • I will not attempt to enter the school without ringing or emailing to make an appointment. • I will support all staff in trying to make the school environment 'as safe as possible' • I will check the school website/social media daily for updates and return missed calls from school. • I will inform school immediately of any changes to emergency contact details for my child. • If my child is deemed unsafe to return to school, I will carry out a risk assessment with Ms Cherry (virtually/remotely), before they can return and deliver the home learning work that is provided.
